

# 199th QM Augments DD00

Defense Distribution Depot Oklahoma City, Oklahoma (DDOO) was augmented this summer by soldiers of the Army Reserve 199th Quartermaster Company from South Bend, Indiana. Forty-five soldiers from the Class IX Repair Parts Company spent two weeks at DDOO working in the Supply Operations Division.

The soldiers were divided into groups that worked in Warehousing, On and Off-Base Transportation and the Preservation, Packaging, Packing & Marking (PPP&M).

The efforts of the soldiers helped to recover \$581,324 in property that was misplaced during rewarehousing of material from building 3705 to building 416. They processed 1000 Issues on the SBSS system to our SBSS customers and 400 Stows as well as sorting and preparing material for transportation to DRMO.

Soldiers working in On- and Off-Base Transportation aided DDOO employees in shipping 1,080 small items and 530 bulk items.

The “take charge” attitude of the soldiers working in PPP&M was contagious. These men and women quickly grasped the workings of the Distribution Standard System (DSS) and were able to reduce DDOO’s backlog by 985 items.

“The hard work, dedication, eagerness to learn new processes and procedures were greatly appreciated,” said Bill Watkins, DDOO Director. The men and women of the 199th QM Company are a great credit to the Army.”

The unit is 92 soldiers strong with CPT Judith Stephenson, USA, as commander and Tommy Vaughn as First Sergeant. In recent training rotations they have alternated between Camp Carol, Korea; Kaiserslauten, Germany; Ft Bragg, NC; Ft Campbell, KY and DDTP, Tobyhanna, PA.
