

DDRT Reusing Tri-walls, Cartons

DDRT is keeping operating costs to a minimum to better support the Warfighter and the taxpayer. One cost saving method also saves shipping supplies. The DDRT Receiving Branch saves excess tri-walls and cartons arriving from vendors and being returned from the field. These items are made available to the Packing and Shipping Branches to be reused to ship material to customers. Every new tri-wall (48X40X36) costs more than \$25. This is a significant savings when coupled with the savings of all other sizes of cartons



received. DDRT is also saving and reusing the cushioning materials (like bubble wrap, peanuts and styrofoam). DDRT receives approximately 8 to 12 full size tri-walls, 20 to 30 cartons and

numerous other sizes cartons weekly that are acceptable for reuse.

“The DDRT Team is always looking for ways to save money and get the best use of every product we handle,” said LTC Hugh Talley, Jr., USA, Commander, DDRT. “Every dollar we save here is one more than can be spent directly on the Warfighter or returned to the taxpayers.”
