CASCOM Instructors Gather Information for RFID Training

Instructors from the U.S. Army's Combined Arms Support Command (CASCOM) visited Defense Distribution Depot Susquehanna, PA (DDSP) for a first-hand account of how Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) technology is used at the Defense Distribution Center (DDC).

The CASCOM instructors, Bob Wendt of Logistics Solutions Group and Richard Mack of Computer Sciences Corporation, teach Warfighters how RFID tags work, how to maintain them and how to access and use the information on the tags.
