



## DDDE's Sulit Named DDC Employee of the Quarter, 2nd Quarter FY04

Leonardo Sulit of Defense Distribution Depot Europe (DDDE) has been named as one of the Defense Distribution Center (DDC) Employees of the Quarter for the second quarter of Fiscal Year 2004 for his outstanding contributions to ensuring inventory accuracy.

During a visit to DDDE earlier this year, DLA Director VADM Keith W. Lippert, SC, USN, commended the distribution center saying that he was "extremely impressed with DDDE's performance, especially in the area of Inventory Accuracy" and that DDDE has the recipe for inventory success. At DDDE, Sulit is considered a key ingredient to that recipe.

In addition to developing the training materials for the program, Sulit was also able to schedule the training in a way that caused no disruption to the daily mission.

As a result of the on-going training program, DDDE was recognized as the only depot to receive 100% in all four categories for DLA/DDC Sample Inventory for the second quarter of Fiscal Year 2004. In addition, this was the third consecutive time that DDDE

met and or exceeded all DLA/DDC Inventory Accuracy goals.

"Mr. Sulit is one of our top performers in DDDE's Inventory Division, a key team player and a remarkable individual who is personally dedicated and intensively involved in every aspect of depot operations. His problem solving techniques are by far the best in the depot," said DDDE Commander LTC Douglas Nomura, USA.

Respected by his teammates, Sulit can be seen during the early morning hours conducting audits in DDDE's picking and packing areas and in the receiving area. A conscientious individual, Sulit single-handedly processed Care of Stock in

Storage (COSIS) functions for the Humanitarian Daily Rations (HDRs)-a major task that took extraordinary coordination with DDDE's Receiving and Issue divisions and the European Command's Veterinarian Inspector to keep stock available and ready at a moment's notice.
