Ms. Lynda Williams received the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Employee of the Quarter Award for the Third Quarter of FY00 from DLA's Director, Lieutenant General Henry T. Glisson, at DLA's Headquarters located on Fort Belvoir, Virginia. Ms. Williams is a Distribution Processing Expeditor assigned to Issue and Shipping Division at Defense Distribution Depot Norfolk, Virginia.

She was nominated for the award because of her ability to support all three major physical distribution processes performed at the depot (stowing receipts, maintaining the readiness of stock and issuing material) and her overall high worker productivity rate. She has been working at the Norfolk Center complex since 1983. She started out as a Warehouse Worker and was re-classified as a Material Handler, subsequent to her present position.

The Defense Logistics Agency is a logistics combat support agency whose primary role is to provide supplies and services to America's military forces worldwide. These services include inventory management, procurement, warehousing and distribution of spare parts, food, clothing, medical supplies and fuel, and reutilization of surplus military materiel. This includes managing over four million consumable items and processing more than 30 million annual distribution actions. Approximately 28,600 civilian and military personnel located in all 50 states and 27 countries perform this worldwide mission.
